

# Spirits at McFerren Park merry and bright despite drizzle, cold

Santa's elves, most dressed in blue jeans and warm coats, gathered at McFerren Park Saturday morning to add holiday cheer to the park.

About 90 volunteers pounded, ratcheted and straightened 17 displays - including five animated ones - and nine arches designed to bring Christmas festivity to Hoopeston.

Volunteers gathered at 8 a.m. for donuts and coffee before heading throughout the park to install the displays and place lights along the fence bordering the park.

In all 37,000 lights will brighten the park, said event organizer Loni Gress.

Gress and Russ Leigh started the drive to decorate the park, asking local businesses for donations towards the décor, which has a retail value of \$400,000, and was purchased from Temple Display of Oswego, Gress said.

Beside the train, which will be at the ball diamond, large displays include an animated Santa's toy company that will be in the area of the swimming pool; and animated Old Man Winter and snow flakes in the northwest corner; and a manger scene for the southeast corner.

Smaller pieces include skaters, alphabet blocks, candy canes and a large Nutcracker.

Along with the fence, lights will also be placed on park shelters, the gazebo and McFerren Park Civic Center. That lighting is expected to be done by parks workers this week, Gress said.

The display will officially be lit November 29 during
