



If you're used to just wheelin' into McFerren Park, you might want to whoa up there just a bit, at least during the Christmas lighting season.

To maintain an orderly flow of traffic through the park starting Friday and continuing through January 4, entry onto Elm Street from Route 1 will be blocked.

However, the Elm Street gate will be the entry and exit point for motorists going through the park to look at the light show, said lighting organizer Loni Gress. To get to that gate, vehicles coming from the north will turn on

Penn, then Sixth Ave. to Elm. All others will turn on Rt. 9 to Sixth Ave., then to Elm. Exiting the park, vehicles will be allowed to turn right on Rt. 1, she said.

Motorists should tune their radios to 88.9 FM to hear Gress in a prerecorded message.

Decorations will be lit at 5 p.m. Saturday when Santa arrives at McFerren Park. Hoopeston Area videographer Tim Walsh, atop Hoopeston Fire Department's ladder truck, will capture the lighting and broadcast it on New Wave Channel 16.
