DACC 'Hour of Code' program at John Greer Thursday

DANVILLE—Kathy Franklin, information systems instructor at Danville Area Community College, is bringing the Hour of Code programming awareness event to students at John Greer Grade School, Thursday, December 11 from 9:20-11:20 am in the school library.

The Hour of Code is a one-hour introduction to computer science, designed to demystify code and show that anybody can learn the basics. The program, a global movement reaching tens of millions of students in 180+ countries is organized by Code.org, a public 501c3 non-profit dedicated to expanding participation in computer

science by making it available in more schools, and increasing participation by women and underrepresented students of color. The Hour of Code is supported by Microsoft, Apple, Amazon, Boys and Girls Clubs of America and the College Board. Organizers and participants believe that every student should have the opportunity to learn computer science as it helps nurture problem-solving skills, logic and creativity.

By starting early, students will have a foundation for success in any 21st-century career path. Information from

the Bureau of Labor Statistics suggests that there will be one million more jobs than qualified computer science applicants by the year 2020. Careers included in the statistic include computer and information research scientists, computer hardware engineers, programmers, support specialists, system analysts and many others

DACC offers a two-year Applied Science degree and certificate in programming and web design, as well as a certificate in computer programming. While this degree and associated certificates are not designed to transfer,

the college has agreements with certain senior institutions for completion of a bachelor's degree. Additionally, anyone may take the first two years of baccalaureate classes at DACC and then transfer to the institution of their choosing to complete a bachelor's degree.
