Hoopeston DACC center gets accreditation designation

DANVILLE—Danville Area Community College recently applied to the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) of the North Central Association – the regional accrediting body for the College – to have its new Hoopeston extension site officially approved as an “additional location.” Part of the approval process required a site visit by a HLC peer reviewer.

Following a visit in early November, DACC officials were pleased to learn that the center has been approved as an “additional location.” This approval means that the college is authorized to offer 50 percent or more of a degree at the site.

“We are grateful to the many community supporters who were instrumental in our establishing a center in Hoopeston,” said Dr. Alice M. Jacobs, DACC president. “The college community is pleased that the Higher Learning Commission agrees that the center is functioning effectively and efficiently in meeting the needs of the Hoopeston community and surrounding areas.”

Karla Coon, Higher Learning Center director, said, “Approval of the Hoopeston Center as an additional location is a great milestone for this young initiative as it will allow us to further broaden our educational offerings for the community. I thank the many community supporters who helped develop this dream from idea to reality. I am honored to play a part in this significant development for the people of my community.”

DACC is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission and is a member of the North Central Association. Institutional accreditation allows a college to participate in federally funded projects; enables students to obtain financial aid and veteran’s services; allows students to
