DACC to host NJCAA Division II men's national basketball tournament for 22nd year

For the 22nd year, Danville Area Community College and the city of Danville will again host the National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) Division II Men's National Basketball Tournament at the DACC campus March 17-21, 2015.

Tournament pairings will not be available until later in March. The top eight teams will be seeded by the Division II Men's Basketball Committee via teleconference once all district champions are determined. The remain-

ing eight teams will be placed on the bracket by blind draw. Each college will play a minimum of two games in the tournament. Teams playing more than two games will determine first through eighth place.

Game times are: Tuesday, March 17: 9 & 11 a.m. morning session; 1 & 3 p.m. afternoon session and 6:30 & 8:30 p.m. evening session. Wednesday, March 18: 11 a.m., 1 & 3 p.m. afternoon session and 6 & 8 p.m. for evening session. Thursday, March 19: 9 & 11 a.m. morning session; 1 p.m. & 3 p.m. for the afternoon session and 6:30 & 8:30 p.m. for the evening session. Friday, March 20: 11 a.m., 1 & 3 p.m. afternoon session and 6 & 8 p.m. for evening session. Saturday, March 21: Noon & 2 p.m. afternoon session and 5:30 & 7:30 p.m.

for evening session.

A tournament pass, which is good for all games, is available for \$45. Tickets are \$8 each session/morning, afternoon or evening. Tickets for DACC students and senior citizens are \$4 and children 6 and under are free for all games.

A 50/50 raffle will be held in conjunction with the tournament. Tickets cost \$1 each. The winning ticket will be drawn Saturday, March 23, during the championship game. Raffle participants need not be present to win. All proceeds from the raffle will support DACC athletic programs.
