

Soil, water stewardship is topic of VCSWCD workshop

Being good stewards of the land and water will be the topic of a workshop March 13 sponsored by Vermilion County Soil and Water Conservation District.

The Soil and Water Stewardship Workshop is scheduled from 8:30 a.m.-2:30 p.m. Friday, March 13 at Vermilion County Farm Bureau Auditorium.

The workshop will include information on best management practices relating to nutrients, soil health and water quality. With the finalization of the Illinois Nutrient Loss Reduction Strategy, there is much discussion on these topics by interested parties in the agricultural industry, government agencies and general public.

The workshop's goal is to provide county farmers with quality, relevant information. Invited speakers include: Hanks Kok, soil health consultant; Dan Schaefer, Illinois N-Watch program; Jean Payne, Illinois Fertilizer & Chemical Association; Jennifer Tirey and Dick Lyons, Illinois CBMP; Lowell Gentry, University of Illinois; ProHarvest Seed cover crop specialists; Full Throttle Ag Service cover crop seeding specialist; AQUA Illinois, Danville water treatment facility staff; SWCD and NRCS staff.

Presentations will include a conversation on Illinois Nutrient Loss Reduction Strategy; Vermilion County water quality impacts; Dynamics of nitrogen management in Illinois; N-Watch program and how to get involved; NREC funded research - your fertilizer tax money at work; Soil Health - incorporating a systems approach; and Cover Crops - opportunities for improvement.

Breakfast refreshments and lunch will be provided. There is no cost to attend the meeting but reservations and RSVPs are required by Monday, March 9.
