A new face

A Hoopeston IGA employee pushes carts through the store's new doorway. The grocery store has been undergoing a \$1.5 million facelift inside and out since last year. As shelves and products were moved for improvements, customers and employees have had a months-long scavenger hunt since work began in August. Improvements include a new façade; entryway with automatic doors leading to a vestibule/cart storage area, followed by a second set of automatic doors leading into the store; wider checkout area; new customer-accessible restrooms; new freezers and coolers; and new office and employee break area. An expanded deli area is still under construction. Product layout has also changed and product offerings expanded.
