Drugs, gun found after Rossville police make traffic stop

Two men were arraigned on drug charges Tuesday in Vermilion County Circuit Court after a traffic stop by Rossville police on Monday night.

Chaz K. Reavill, 40, who listed a Georgetown address, and Allen L. Richmond, 47, of Rossville, were each charged with possession of methamphetamine, a Class 3 crime; possession of methamphetamine precursor, a Class 2 charge.

Additionally, Reavill was charged with no FOID (revoked card), a class 3 charge, and no FOID card, a class A charge.

According to a press release issued by Rossville

police, the traffic stop was made at 9:47 p.m. Monday at Steward and South Summit.

During the stop, the investigating officer found an AR 15 rifle, large amount of ammunition and a loaded magazine between Reavill, the driver, and Richmond, the passenger.

Both men were being held in the Public Safety Building in Danville in lieu of bond, set at \$30,000 (10%) set for Allen and \$100,000 (10%) set for Reavill.

Both men are expected to appear for a preliminary hearing on March 19.
