Council approves agreement for Route 1 main extension

Hoopeston City Council on Tuesday approved giving Mayor Bill Crusinberry the authority to sign an engineering agreement, the first step towards installing a bigger water main along Route 1.

The agreement, between the city and Farnsworth

Group, will include a preliminary engineering design and oversight of the project, estimated at \$250,000 for construction and another \$50,000 in engineering fees.

coming from the city's Tax Increment Financing (TIF) fund, would replace the existing 4" water main with a new 8" main from Penn to Crown Ford, said Mike Streff, engineer with Farnsworth Group.

The city will have to get utility easement approval from businesses along the route before the new main is put in. The project will also include new fittings, hydrants and repositioning of some meters.

Crusinberry first brought up replacing that main in 2011. In 2012, officials hoped to include the work as part of the northern main extension but that was not allowed by the EPA.

In May 2012, the project was scrapped when an initial estimate of \$125,000 to \$129,000 grew to \$147,000 plus other costs that could have totaled \$202,000 and would require Illinois Department of Transportation approval as a project separate from northbound work.

In other business, the council:

- Unanimously approved spending not more than \$6,200 with Russ Leigh & Associates for the audit.
- Tabled an employee salary range ordinance after Alderman Randy Carter complained that the \$840 per month salary for the pool manager is "ludicrous. That's not even minimum wage," he said.
- Accepted ownership of the former Second Chance Saloon, 102 N. Market. The building will be demolished.
