### Education budget may get done if reforms are made

It's now less than two weeks before the beginning of the next fiscal year, and we still don't have a balanced budget plan in place. There was a small bit of news this week that was

viewed by many as a good development. A handful of news stories noted that there was a possibility that both Senate President John Cullerton and Governor Bruce Rauner might be able to reach consensus on an education budget, if it contained school funding reform.

Advisory Committee, which studied how the current formula works, including why it seems to create inequity between school districts.

There is definitely one thing we can all agree on, that a student's zip code shouldn't determine the quality of their education. But the question is how we go about reforming the system. There are a multitude of bills that have been filed with differing methods to accomplish that goal. The big problem is that most of them haven't even been heard in committee.

I am the sponsor of one such bill, SB1402, which is supported by a broad coalition of school districts, super-intendents, school boards and parents known as Vision 20/20. This legislation would create an evidence-based funding model to replace our current formula. That means a system where school funding is based on the

actual costs each district faces. This would be a scalable system, which would more equitably distribute education funds regardless of the total amount set aside by lawmakers. It would also allow us to see how increases and decreases actually affect schools, such as how much money it would take to reduce class sizes to a level that would better educate our students.

This is the method our schools and our parents are asking for, and the common-sense solution that our children deserve. But so far this bill hasn't even been allowed to be heard in committee. I agree with our Senate

president that we need to tackle school funding reform. But starting that process means looking at the best proposals, including this one, and not simply pushing one particular piece of legislation that is viewed as more politically advantageous.


