Flooding, damage accompany fast-moving storm Monday

A quick storm Monday morning caused flooding and damage in Hoopeston.

Nearly an inch of rain fell in the storm, which lasted less than an hour. The rain caused streets to be temporarily flooded on the northeast side. Other low-lying areas, including yards, were flooded, as well.

Winds nearing 40 m.p.h. damaged trees around the

city, including at John Greer Grade School and at the corner of Penn and Sixth St., where a metal shed was blown from the backyard to the parkway, where it rested near a downed tree branch.

Residents were asked to remain vigilant for the remainder of the day as the possibility of stronger storms existed for the afternoon and nighttime.
