## Unneeded buses equal big savings towards new HA bus

A three-for-one trade means Hoopeston Area will get a new 16-passenger bus with a lift for about \$6,000.

At Thursday's school board meeting, transportation director Mark Eighner said three buses, including a malfunctioning lift and two buses no longer in service totaled a trade in of \$50,500 on the little more than \$56,000 purchase price, Eighner said.

In other business, the board:

- Hired Keli Egan, kindergarten teacher; Megan Tucker, middle school special ed teacher; and Jessica Watson, part time Honeywell lunch aide.
- Approved transferring Amanda Elliott from high

school personal aide to classroom/study hall aide.

- Approved Rebecca Sadler's resignation as middle/high school home ec teacher, effective immediately.
- Approved Ryan DeVore as high school golf volunteer.
- Approved a high school bowling program.
