Final high school registration will be held Thursday, from 8:30-11 a.m. and 12:30-3:30 p.m.

Registration for ECSE and grades K-6 will be held from 1-6 p.m. Wednesday, Aug. 12., at Honeywell Elementary School. Special registration assistance will be available to Spanish speaking families at that time.

Registration forms are available on the district website, www.hoopeston.k12.il.us. To speed up the registration process, forms may be printed, filled out and taken to registration.

School supply lists are also available on the site.

Freshman/parent orientation will be 5-5:45 p.m. Wednesday, Aug. 12 in the high school auditorium.

Book fees for the year are \$25 for Early Childhood and \$50 for K-12 students.

Other fees for the year include:

- Middle/high school activity fee: \$20 per activity with a maximum of \$40 per student, \$80 per family.
- Driver education: ninth graders are required to take driver education. Cost is \$50.

• Health education: ninth graders are required to take health. The district will provide CPR training for each student. Cost is \$10 per student.

- Spanish I, II and III: \$20 for workbook
- Government class: \$12 for weekly magazine
- Accounting I and II: \$20 for workbook
- Agriculture class: \$6 for access code to EZ Records
- Advanced Placement Courses: \$80 each. The fee pays for the AP Exam in May.

Illinois requires all kindergarten, sixth and ninth grade students have health physicals before the start of school for students, on August 24.

Students involved in sports will be required to have a sports physical to participate in sports this year. Sports physicals will be available for \$15 from 2-4 p.m. Tuesday, Aug. 4, at Charlotte Ann Russell Medical Center, 801 E. Orange, Hoopeston.
