National DAR, local chapter commemorate anniversaries

Barbara Standish Chapter NSDAR honored the National Society Daughters of the American Revolution with a reception for the 125th Anniversary of the national organization Sunday, Oct. 11, 2015 at the Hoopeston Public Library.

The chapter celebrated its own 110th Anniversary during the same event.

The National Society Daughters of the American Revolution originated with a group of 18 women meeting one afternoon on October 11, 1890 at the Strathmore Arms in Washington, D. C.

The women, with different backgrounds from rural and urban areas, held one thing in common: a direct line to a revolutionary ancestor or patriot and the desire to honor them.

Their mission was to form a society dedicated to the service of historical preservation, education and patriotism.

One of the founders, Caroline Harrison, the wife of then-President Benjamin Harrison, became the

first President General. In Illinois, Chicago was the first Illinois city to organize a chapter on March 20, 1891. Barbara Standish Chapter, the local Hoopeston chapter, was the first to organize in Vermilion County on September 8, 1905, receiving its charter October 4, 1905. The charter was displayed prominently at the first meeting October 12, 1905.

Area guests included members from Alliance Chapter of Champaign/Urbana; Princess Wach-E-Kee Chapter, Watseka; Jacqueline Lacy, candidate for States Attorney; one pending Barbara Standish member and two prospective members.

Several local residents from Hoopeston, Ross-ville, Watseka, Gifford, and Champaign also attended.

Letters were received from National President General Lynn Forney Young, the Illinois State Regent Sharon Crumbaker Frizzell and District III Director Dr. Julie Elbert.
