**Fund established to help pay expenses of shooting victim**

A GoFundMe account has been set up to help cover costs of a rural Rankin man who was shot last week.

Jeri Roberts, niece of Sharon and Don Frazier, set up the account, which had raised \$4,600 from 48 donors in 18 hours. The account has a goal of \$50,000.

Don Frazier was beaten and shot multiple times last Thursday, allegedly by Vernon Scott Lee, the

estranged husband of his stepdaughter, Emily Lee.

According to published reports, a friend dropped Lee off at his in-laws' home at about 9:30 a.m. It is unknown if Mr. Frazier was home when Lee arrived or if he came home after Lee was already in the home. view Mr. Frazier about the incident.

Then, using Mrs. Frazier's phone, Lee texted his estranged wife, Emily Lee, about a problem at the house. Emily Lee, and her boyfriend, Jeff Turner, went to the house, where Turner was also shot.

Vermilion County Sheriff's Department received a call about shots being fired at about 4:50 p.m.

Lee left the Frazier home and went to his Rankin home, where he shot himself. He is recovering from his injuries.

Mr. Frazier, Turner and Lee were all taken to Carle Foundation Hospital. Mr. Frazier was still listed in critical condition this week.

As of Tuesday, no charges had been filed against Lee, who was the subject of an order of protection initiated by Emily Lee.
