Purdue University Extension and University of Illinois Extension are collaborating to offer the annual Bi-State Crop Management Conference, being held at The Beef House Restaurant on Tuesday, Dec. 1. Registration begins at 8:30 a.m. EST (7:30 a.m. CST), and the presenters will begin promptly at 9 a.m. EST.

The Beef House is located at 16501 Indiana State Road 63, Covington, Ind.

The program features Kiersten Wise, Purdue Extension Plant Disease Specialist, sharing her presentation "Solving Path(ology) Problems for the Future." Following Wise, Dennis Bowman, University of Illinois Crop

Specialist, will present "Drones on the Farm: Tools and/or Toys." The morning session will also feature the topic "Prices Outlooks & Budgets," and Aaron Hager, University of Illinois Weeds Specialist, will present "TakeACTION Against Marestail & Waterhemp."
