Memorial gift honors woman, offers access to family records

A memorial gift from Hoopeston Historical Society honors one of its longest members and gives the gift of genealogical research to residents.

The historical society has donated the first year of Ancestry.com to Hoopeston Public Library. The gift was given in memory of Jean Minick.

Ancestry.com is an online site which provides a wide range of genealogy search tools and a vast collection of vital records, including census and military records and published family genealogies. The service is available free to library patrons, but can only be accessed via computer from the library.

HPL also offers links to several other genealogy services on its website (www.hooplib.org), including Heritage Quest, Family Search and Find A Grave. These services can be accessed from home via the library website, but Heritage Quest requires a valid HPL library card to use.

The library, in conjunction with the historical society, is planning a series of workshops beginning in January

2016 to help residents get acquainted with the various online research sites and get started in searching their family trees.
