Hoopeston Area plans to borrow in anticipation of new law

Board learns wind farm, increased cost of farmland to boost EAV, levy

A bill currently in the Illinois Senate, which would freeze property taxes has Hoopeston Area officials looking at issuing bonds.

At Thursday's school board meeting, SB 318 was discussed. If the bill passes, and Supt. Hank Hornbeck said it appears it will, property taxes will be frozen at the 2015 level for 2016 and 2017.

In a worst-case financial scenario during the freeze, Hoopeston Area would not be able to borrow money without putting a referendum on a ballot, "We couldn't

borrow without going to the voters," Hornbeck said, adding in the current climate "not many referendums are passing."

Hoopeston Area does not often borrow money - the most recent loan was for the Maple School addition in the 90s - but the current board wants to give future boards "the ability to borrow a little bid of money," he

The board hopes to issue working cash Fund bonds to establish a debt base. Hornbeck has previously referred to the working cash fund as a sort of district savings



account. In June, it had about \$1.7 million, Hornbeck said, but about \$300,000 was taken from the fund to pay for Chromebooks earlier this year.

The board plans to use First Midstate, Inc., of Bloomington, for the bond issue and will hold a public hearing on the bonds at the December 19 meeting.

In related financial discussion, the board learned the district's equalized assessed valuation (EAV) will increase by \$4.2 million because of increased taxes from the local wind farm and because the price of farmland has increased. That is a 15.4 percent increase, Hornbeck

The higher EAV means the district's property tax levy is expected to increase to an estimated \$3.4 million, up from an estimated \$2.9 million for 2014. "It's great news for school districts," Hornbeck said. "Actually, it's great news for all taxing bodies.
