New vendor-based shop opens Friday in downtown Hoopeston

A staid, stately building downtown is being reincarnated into something less somber.

Joyce Allen, owner of the former Nelson Law Office building at 112 E. Main, has transformed the building into Joyce's Then, Now & Beyond.

Allen, and her sister, Leona York, decided on the venture earlier this year, which allows local vendors to showcase their wares, with each vendor getting a room.

On Monday, work was still going on to get the shop ready for a grand opening on Friday. Allen's nephew-by-marriage, Gary Warf, brought the store's street sign to hang. Warf will also be a vendor at the shop.

Another vendor, Christie Goodrum, painted a table a light shade of green as she readied her room for the opening.

Other vendors include Margie Brown, Sharon Potter and Nancy Puller, but there's room for two or three more on the first floor, plus there's the whole second floor. That includes the law library room and a long, solid wooden one-piece table that came to be in the building by being lifted through a window by a crane, said Allen, who sounded hesitant to open the upstairs up to just any vendor. "It would have to be something pretty special," she said.
