Inspection firm chosen but you can't get there from here

A new business will take over golf cart inspections for Hoopeston - as soon as a way is designated to get the carts there legally.

Reliable Auto, 517½ S. Dixie Hwy., will perform golf cart inspections since the former inspection site - Neal Tire - closed, said Alderman Brandon Hamilton.

The drawback to the new inspection center is that there is no way for golf cart owners to legally drive their

carts there to be inspected.

By ordinance, golf carts may not travel on either Rtes 1 or 9 and may only cross Rt. 9 at Seventh St., Market and South Second and Sixth avenues. No crossing points are allowed on Rt. 1 inside or outside the city limits.

Hamilton said the logistics issue will be addressed and

the solution publicized.

Resident Chuck Wallace, during the public comment part of the meeting, expressed concern about the safety of golf carts crossing the highway, wondering about the liability of “hundreds (crossing), not one in a blue moon.” Wallace affirmed Reliable Auto as a good choice because owner Shawn Cade “actually works on golf carts.”

In related discussion, Mayor Bill Crusinberry said he emailed the corporate office of Neal Tire nearly two weeks ago to try to find out if the abrupt closure on No-

vember 3 is final and what plans the company has for the building on Penn St., but has not received a reply.

Wallace, who managed the business until it closed, said he had no answers.

In other business, the council heard from engineer Mike Streff, of Farnsworth Group, who said the water storage refurbishment project has not been finalized because a subcontractor is being investigated for discrepancies in employee benefits and payroll and the general contractor, Leander Construction, is

withholding final payment pending the outcome of that investigation.

Also, Leander was unaware that project documents called for a two-year warranty on work and “is scrambling” to get a two-year maintenance agreement in place, he said. Leander is also trying to get a one-year agreement to coincide with Quality Assured Industrial Coating’s three-year guarantee on the exterior coating.

Streff said the city will save nearly \$23,000 due to a clerical error on a quantities adjustment, bringing

the final cost of the refurbishment project to \$2,526,000 “in round numbers.”

In unrelated discussion, Crusinberry said he was contacted by Cobblestone Hotels, which may have interest in locating a motel in Hoopeston.

The company had previously declined to consider Hoopeston for a motel.


