HA Middle School to celebrate new STEM lab in new year

Hoopeston Area Middle School will celebrate the new year with its new STEM lab.

A ribbon cutting for the lab will be held at 10 a.m. January 13, said Principal Ann Burton at Thursday's Hoopeston Area School Board meeting.

About 18 months in the making, the lab will focus on STEM (science, technology, engineering, math) courses, giving students some hands-on experience with things such as 3D printers and will be used by middle and high school students.

In other action, the board:

• Approved the \$3,458,500 tax levy, up 15.4 percent

over last year.

- Approved a two-year agreement with Schlarman Academy continuing the co-op football program. High school Principal Larry Maynard said the agreement is basically the same as the first one, with the major change being the number of games that will be played at each school.
- Approved a one-year extension of the Tri-Party Deactivation agreement with Rossville-Alvin and Bismarck-Henning, which allows RA students to choose to attend high school at either Hoopeston or Bismarck.
- Approved re-employing Bill Nelson as district attorney with a \$2,000 retainer. Along with legal issues, Nelson also acts as hearing officer for student discipline matters, said Supt. Hank Hornbeck.
- Approved Brian Hodge as athletic director, beginning December 17.
- Approved Stephanie Pratt as assistant high school soccer coach, beginning Deember 17.
- Approved Mark White as John Greer personal aide, beginning December 17.
- Accepted John Klaber's resignation as assistant soccer coach, effective December 7.
