Rural Hoopeston woman held on bond following stabbing

A rural Hoopeston woman is being held on \$100,000 bond in connection with a stabbing in the early morning hours Sunday at her home.
 Lisa M. Bitzel, 50, was arrested Monday by Iroquois County Sheriff's deputies at her home at 0950 N 1700 East Rd.
 Deputies were called to Bitzel's home early Sunday morning, following a 911 call from Steve Hofbauer, 61, of Rankin, who said he had been stabbed several times by his girlfriend.

Deputies arrived to find Hofbauer in his car outside Bitzel's home, with multiple stab wounds. He was taken to Carle Foundation Hospital, Urbana, for treatment. The wounds were not considered life-threatening.
 Bitzel was arrested and charged with aggravated domestic battery. She appeared in Iroquois County Circuit Court Tuesday, where bond was set. She was remanded back to the jail in lieu of \$10,000 cash bond.
