Just in time for Valentines Day, Hoopeston City Hall has a piece of equipment that can keep a heart going.

An automatic external defibrillator (AED) has been installed on a wall near the display case in the lobby.

The device was purchased with an \$1.106 grant from the Region 6 Coalition grant, said Charlotte Strawser. BSN, emergency management specialist at Carle Hoopeston Regional Health Center.

Carle Hoopeston is one of 16 hospitals in the coalition.

alerted.

Taking the AED from the box, Bookwalter displayed the pads that are connected to the brains of the equipment and placed on a person's chest. If the defibrillator detects a heartbeat, it will not shock the person. 'It won't shock if a shock is not required," Strawser said.

Instead, a mechanical voice will instruct that CPR should be started.

No training is needed to operate the user-friendly AED. Along with talking and pictures, the unit also includes lighted guides to tell a Good Samaritan what the defibrillator found.

Anita Guffey, director of disaster preparedness for Carle Hospital, Urbana, is chairman of the Region 6 Coalition, part of Illinois' emergency management system.

Along with Carle Hoopeston and Carle Foundation Hospital, which is the lead facility for the area, other hospitals in the group include Iroquois Memorial in Watseka; Gibson Area Hospital, Gibson City; Crawford Memorial Hospital, Robinson; Decatur Memorial Hospital; Kirby Hospital, Monticello; Lawrence
