to park cars in them," Tarter said.

Other items came from the brothers' purchase of entire estates, storage units or local auctions.

The Tarters first considered opening a resale shop, based on their addiction to finding things to fix, but decided on an online auction business for a couple reasons. First, both are busy. Russell Tarter is a plumber in the Champaign-Urbana area and he and his wife, Kerianne, have a one-year-old son, Logan. Dustin works for the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign College of Liberal Arts and Sciences as assistant director of advising and student services.

Tarter credits his parents with instilling "busyness" in their sons. "Our parents aren't the type of people that let grass grow under their feet, so I guess it rubbed off on us," he said, adding the brothers idea of fun has always been "tinkering with things and making them better."

Second, he said, not everyone likes live auctions, where a person must make a split second decision. Also, some potential buyers are unwilling to wait through an entire auction for the one item they want.

With the Tarters' system, people can peruse items at the storefront during preview periods (or through the front windows as many people have been spotted doing) or see pictures online, at <u>www.corntownauctions.com</u>.
