**Multi Agency to shuttle voters to McFerren Park for primary**

Hoopeston voters who wish to cast ballots in Tuesday's primary election but who don't want to deal with parking at the McFerren Park Civic Center can be shuttled to the polling place.

Hoopeston Multi Agency will run its shuttle to the civic center in 15-minute increments. Rides will be available from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. The round trip fare is \$2 per person.

Those who wish to use the shuttle service are asked to call the Multi Agency, (217) 283-5544, by noon Tuesday to schedule a ride. Normally, the bus stops at 2:30 p.m. daily, but the bus will run until polls close at 7 p.m.,

if there is a need.

No trips to the Civic Center will be made from 12-1 p.m. on election day.
