Gary R. Wilson, 41, of Hoopeston, was cited unlawful deposits of garbage on a complaint from a 63-year-old Hoopeston man.

The incident occurred at 2:50 p.m. Tuesday in the alley of the 900 block of East Main after Wilson allegedly left piles of ashes and garbage on the man's property. The man alleged he asked Wilson several times to clean up the area.

Wilson was given a notice to appear in Hoopeston City Court.

Two Hoopeston boys were arrested after an incident at 6:55 p.m. Tuesday in the 800 block of South

Sixth Ave. The boys, ages 14 and 16, were charged with disorderly conduct on a complaint from a 16-year-old boy who alleged that when the two asked him for money he owed them, he saw what appeared to be a gun in one of the boys' hands.

Police found the boys and took them to the police station where they were questioned with their parents, and searched. That led to the 16-year-old being charged with possession of drug paraphernalia after a cannabis pipe was reportedly found.

Both boys were released to their parents. No gun was reported found.
