# High wind blows through area leaving damage in wake

Larry Baughn, of WHPO radio, experienced a first Saturday at the station's annual business expo.

Baughn said the expo has been in held in mild temperatures, cold temperatures, driving rain and blinding snow but for the first time he could remember, part of Saturday's event was held without power.

The expo opened with power but high winds cut it short, knocking out power not only to the expo, but also to most businesses located along the intersection of Rtes. 1 and 9.

As visitors waited, students of the Okinawan School of Karate practiced before their scheduled performance. When the lights came back on in the McFerren Park Civic Center, electricity received a rousing round of applause, followed by one for the students' efforts.

Vermilion County and others were under a high wind advisory for most of Saturday, with winds routinely in the 30 m.p.h. category, with gusts reported and 50 and 60 m.p.h.

On North Market, a street light rested on its lamp, blocking the street in front of the Hoopeston Fire Station. At McFerren Park, a utility pole snapped, landing on the Pony League Field fence.

Driving on city streets was, at times, like driving an obstacle course as motorists dodged tree limbs, rolling See WIND on other side

Hoopeston Fire Department responded to two windrelated calls Saturday, one at 11:56 a.m., for an activated alarm at Teasdale Foods, caused by power outages, and at 1:36 p.m., firemen were called to the 1300 block of South Second Ave., for wires that were down and arcing, which resulted in a fire.

Firemen extinguished the fire and Ameren employees were on site to repair the wires.

Winds downed lines and poles and in Vermilion County with 4,000 customers reported without power Saturday. Sunday's Ameren outage map showed all power had been restored.
