Severe weather spotter class to be held Thursday in Tilton

The National Weather Service, in conjunction with Vermilion County Emergency Management Agency, will conduct a Severe Weather Spotters Training Class at 6:30 p.m. Thursday, April 7 at the Tilton Community Center, 612 West 5th St. in Tilton. Doors open at 6 p.m.

A meteorologist from the National Weather Service office in Lincoln will be the instructor. The class is for experienced spotters to maintain their qualification as Certified Weather Spotters and is also open to the general public for those who would like some severe weather training.

Local EMA personnel will be on hand to answer local based questions on severe weather reporting and procedures.

The class will be approximately 2½-3 hours long. No reservations needed.

Severe storm spotters are a vital part of the warning process. Spotters provide critical, potentially life saving information to their communities and surrounding locations and to NWS forecasters who are using reports to help issue warnings and keep the public updated during severe weather events.
