Maple Grade School sets 2016 kindergarten registration

Youngsters who will be five on or before September 1 are eligible to attend kindergarten in the fall. Maple Grade School is holding registration to allow parents to get their future students enrolled.

Registration will be from 8:30-11 a.m. and 1-5:30 p.m. on Tuesdays, April 12 and 19 at Maple. Screenings must be done before students are assigned to a class.

Parents are asked to bring or send their child's birth certificate, social security card, shots record and dental and vision records.
