Council approves Motor Fuel Tax street repairs in city

Several streets in Hoopeston will be improved after Hoopeston City Council approved a \$160,000 street repair project.

The work will be done as part of the annual Motor Fuel Tax work.

Included in the project is \$36,000 of concrete work to be done on:

- The east side of Third St. between Main and Penn at the church.
- The east side North Bank between Main and Railroad St. at the motel.
- The north side of Penn between the alley and Market at the former city hall.
- The east side of First Ave., between Main and Penn, at Hoopeston Multi Agency.
- The west side of Bank, between Main and Penn, at the entrance to First Farmers Bank and Trust.
- The south side of Main between Sixth and Seventh St. Asphalt and seal coat work totaling just under \$84,000 is expected to be done on:
- Eighth St. between McNeil and Judson.
- Wyman between Front and Market.
- Railroad St. between Bank and Market.
- Elm between Fifth and Sixth.
- Chestnut between Market and Third.
- Maple, between Sixth and Eighth avenues.
- Lockhart off of Rt. 9.

An additional \$25,000 will be spent on aggregate to be stockpiled in the city.

The city received \$200,000 in MFT funds but is banking \$40,000 for the Thompson resurfacing project, expected to be done next year.

In other business, the council:

• Approved an \$8,500 perpetual care bid from Treasured Roots Flower Shop for 127 live flower and 63 artificial vases and urns.

- Heard from Ald. Bill McElhaney hat jetting and televising the sewer line on the north side is underway.
- Approved a stop sign on the northwest and southeast corners of East Seminary and Eighth St.
- Learned applications for the administrative coordinator position will be accepted until April 18.
- Heard from Ald. Alex Houmes that applications for lifeguards and pool manager are available at city hall.
- Learned from Hoopeston Jaycee Brad Hardcastle that this year's festival will have a pageant but it will not be related to the Miss America pageant.
