# HA board of education approves administrator pay hikes

Hoopeston Area administrators - and other 12-month salaried employees - were each given a \$1,000 raise for 2016-17.

The board voted on the increase at Thursday's monthly board meeting.

The increase means Supt. Hank Hornbeck, who will retire in 2017, will have a base salary of \$130.675.82. based on salary information posted on the district's web-

With the increase, Larry Maynard, high school principal, will go to \$94,738.02; Maple principal Lori Eells, Maple to \$91,032.39; Dan Walder, John Greer principal, \$74,287.02; Anne Burton, middle school principal, \$74,287.02; and Suzi Root, Honeywell principal, \$68,950.

Along with salaries, administrators also have districtpaid retirement and health and life insurance.

In other personnel issues, the board:

- Approved Ashley Gondzur as high school summer credit recovery English teacher.
- Approved resignations of Anna Brutlag as Title I aide and Mark White as John Greer personal aide, both effective at the end of the school year.
- Approved Ross Bryll's resignation as assistant football

coach, effective March 18.

- Approved Carlos Ramos as football volunteer, effective April 21.
- Approved Family and Medical Leave Act request of Penny Connor for the rest of the school year.
- Hired Kyle Ramos as assistant high school football coach, effective April 21.
- Approved salaries of Tim Hillard, mark Eighner, Rodney Comstock and Curt Spaur for the 2016-17 year.
- Tabled until May hiring a student services coordinator at Maple.

In unrelated business:

• Hornbeck talked about Illinois' overpayment of \$168 million to taxing bodies in the state. Hoopeston Area's share of the total is \$75,094.43. "The good news is we don't have to write them a check," he said, adding the state will deduct the overpayment over time.

Hornbeck said the overage was in personal property replacement tax, a tax collected by the state and paid to local governments after the state eliminated personal property taxes on corporations, partnerships and other business entities.

- Hornbeck also said district health insurance costs rose by 9.5 percent this year, less that the 20 percent costs would have risen if Hoopeston Area had not had a multi-year contract for insurance. The hike will add \$56 per month to the cost of single coverage, which will be split between the district and employee.
- The board approved the high school Chromebook Acceptable Use Police, effective at the start of the 2016-17 year.
- The board also approved the John Greer eligibility policy and the new high school football co-op agreement for 2016-17 and 2017-18 with Schlarman Academy and Armstrong Potomac.
