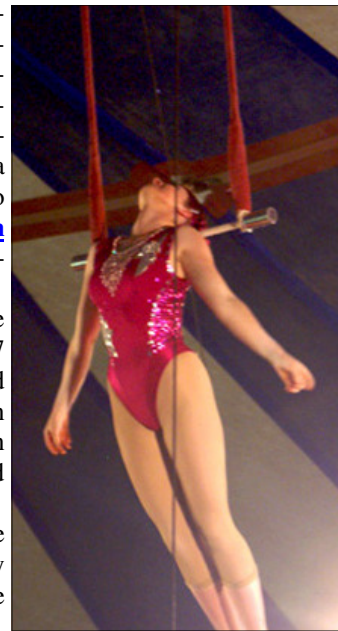
All acts are accompanied by original music composed by the talented, Matt Margucci from Los Angeles, Calif.
