A **21-year-old** Hoopeston man is facing several preliminary charges after police allege he was driving recklessly.

Officers were investigating a criminal damage report at 2:13 a.m. Thursday in the 500 block of West Lincoln when Nathan Z. Blanton allegedly drove past them at a high rate of speed, nearly hitting an officer.

Police pursued throughout town, as Blanton report-

edly drove into a yard, hitting a tree and driving on before being stopped in the 300 block of North Eighth Ave., where he allegedly fought officers.

Preliminary charges include aggravated fleeing or attempting to elude, resisting arrest, reckless driving, operating an uninsured motor vehicle, speeding (60 mph in a 23 mph zone), leaving the scene of an accident, two counts of disobeying a stop sign, two counts of disobeying a yield sign, three counts of failure to signal when required, illegal transportation of alcohol and failure to reduce speed to avoid an accident.

Blanton was taken to the Public Safety Building in Danville to await arraignment.
