County issued final multiplier

SPRINGFIELD—Vermilion County has been issued a final property assessment equalization factor of 1.0000, according to Constance Beard, Director of the Illinois Department of Revenue.

The equalization factor, often called the “multiplier,” is the method used to achieve uniform property assessments among counties, as required by law. Equalization is particularly important because some of the state's 6,600 local taxing districts overlap into two or more counties (e.g. school districts, junior college districts, fire protection districts). Without equalization among counties, substantial inequities among taxpayers with comparable properties would result.

By law, Illinois property should be assessed at one-third of its market value. Farm property is assessed differently, with farm homesites and dwellings subject to regular assessing and equalization procedures, and farmland assessed at one-third its agriculture economic value. Farmland is not subject to the state equalization factor.

Vermilion County assessments are at 33.49 percent of market value. The equalization factor is being assigned for 2015 taxes, payable in 2016.

Each county's multiplier is determined yearly by comparing the price of individual properties sold over the past three years to the assessed value placed on those properties by the county supervisor of assessments/county assessor.

A change in the equalization factor does not mean total property tax bills will increase or decrease. Tax bills are determined by local taxing bodies' requests for money. If amounts requested by taxing districts is not more than the amount received in the previous year, then total property taxes will not increase.
