**Wellington man dies from injuries in bicycle-semi accident**

A Wellington man has died from injuries received in a bicycle/semi accident.  
 Rick Ried, 58, was riding his bicycle on Innovation Road west of Rantoul shortly after 9 a.m. Tuesday when police say he hit a parked semi-trailer tractor.  
 A Rantoul patrol officer said Mr. Ried flipped off of his bicycle after the collision. He was nonresponsive at the scene and was taken by ambulance to Carle Foundation Hospital.  
 The truck driver, Ricardo D'Andre, of Kingsville,

Ontario, filling out his log book at the time of the accident, according to reports. He was uninjured.  
 He is survived by his wife, Denise; daughters Amanda Kitterman, of Lincoln and Bethany Burt of Danville; a son, Derek, of Lincoln; four brothers; five grandchildren and several in-laws.  
 Mr. Ried worked at Jeld-Wen in Rantoul for 26 years and was active in many church, youth and cycling groups.  
 Visitation will be from 3-7 p.m. Sunday at Anderson Funeral Home, Hoopeston. Funeral will be at 11 a.m.

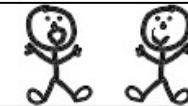
