## Hoopeston to save money on summer street repair project

Hoopeston will save a bit on its summer street program, after bids for tar and chip and concrete came in under estimates.

Ald. Randy Carter, street/alley committee chairman, announced at Tuesday's Hoopeston City Council meeting that Ribbe Trucking submitted the only bid for tar and chip work, at \$74867.20.

Five bids were received for concrete work, ranging

from a high of \$74,840 from an unidentified company, to the lowest bid, \$41,262.40, from Silver Brothers of Hoopeston, which was accepted.

Carter said the city had budgeted \$160,000 of Motor Fuel Tax money for the work. The bids total 116,129.60.

Other costs, including engineering fees, are not included in the total.

## Repairs continued from other side

City employees are doing prep work before streets are repaired and one street on East Lincoln has been closed due to upcoming street and rail crossing repairs. "We hope that people understand and will bear with us," he said.

In related action, the council approved a bid of \$4.19 per sq. ft. from Built-2-Last Construction for the 50-50 sidewalk program. The cost is "a little bit less than what it was last year" at \$4.38, Carter said. Handicapped-accessible curbs will cost \$5.19 per sq. ft.
