## State survey seeks farmers' input on nutrient loss practices

SPRINGFIELD—Farmers should keep an eye on their mailboxes this month for an important survey that could help change the future of Illinois agriculture.

On July 1, Heartland Regional Field Office of the United States Department of Agriculture National Agricultural Statistics Service (USDA-NASS) began mailing surveys asking Illinois farmers about techniques they use in accordance with the state's Nutrient Loss Reduction Strategy (NLRS).

The NLRS is a joint effort by Illinois Department of Agriculture, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, Illinois Water Resources Center, and several public and

private stakeholders and is one of 31 other state strategies developed and implemented across the Mississippi River basin, intended to improve the nation's water quality.

The survey will ask farmers about crop production practices, including: use of cover crops, tillage strategies and nutrient application strategies. The survey will also ask questions about fields and tiling.

 Hoopeston Area residents are asked to take part in a survey to determine characteristics wanted in a new superintendent. The survey is on the district website, [www.hoopeston.k12.il.us](http://www.hoopeston.k12.il.us), and will be available until July 13.

**Survey continued from other side**  
 A high participation rate will help Illinois prove that Illinois does not need additional mandates; that Illinois farmers and ranchers can make a difference through voluntary involvement; and that producers have taken ownership of the issue and are willing and able to meet the challenge.  
 Representatives with USDA-NASS hope to have all survey data collection complete by September 15, but to do this need a prompt return of surveys. These surveys will be a part of the Strategy's bi-annual progress report. This requirement of the state strategy is designed to help evaluate what best management practices are working throughout the state.
