Randy Carter, lifelong resident, alderman, volunteer dies

A man who was the driving force behind many organizations in Hoopeston has died.

Randy Earl Carter, 67, of Hoopeston, died at 5:31 a.m. Friday, Sept. 9, 2016, at home.

Mr. Carter, the son of Earl Oscar and Dorothy (Egnew) Carter, was a lifelong Hoopeston resident, graduating Hoopeston High School before attending Northern Illinois University. He served in the United States Air Force from 1968-72 and returned to Hoopeston, where he was a banker at City National Bank for 25 years. A previous owner of Star Chrysler, he most recently worked for Iroquois Paving in Watseka.

It was in the area of volunteerism that Mr.

Carter will be missed the most, according to friends and acquaintances. Online condolences spoke of his community spirit and dedication to goals he believed would improve Hoopeston.

He was a member of Hoopeston Star Lodge, Gao Grotto and past member of Hoopeston Jaycees, where he served as a JCI Senator. He was active in Hoopeston American Legion Post 384, where he served as adjutant and was active in helping with bingo and other events.

In 2011, Mr. Carter was elected to the Hoopeston City Council, where he represented Ward 2. He was chairman of the street and alley committee and also served on the police and finance committees.

Mr. Carter is survived by his wife, Rita (Scott), a daughter, Tanya (Rob) Obenland, of Milford; a son, Seth (Megan), of Bloom-

ington; five grandchildren; one great-granddaughter; two brothers; a step-brother; and one half sister.


