VCHD survey to be used in community assessment plan

DANVILLE – The Vermilion County Health Department is beginning its five-year community assessment, and is asking residents to take a short survey to help with the process.

The Illinois Project for Local Assessment of Needs (IPLAN) is a community health assessment and planning process that is conducted every five years by local health departments in Illinois. The three essential elements of IPLAN are an assessment of the organization's capacity, a community health needs assessment, and a community health plan which focuses on at least three priority health problems.

For its 2012 IPLAN report, the health department reviewed data from the U.S. Census, the Illinois Department of Public Health, the Center for Disease Control, The Illinois State Police and other sources, held community forums and collected surveys from 1,235 county residents.

Using that input, the health department determined that the three areas of concern for the community to focus on were substance abuse, obesity and teen pregnancy.

For its 2017 IPLAN report, the health department staff has prepared a new community assessment survey, which is available for residents at the health department, through

its community partners, on its website, www.vchd.org and its Facebook page.

"We want to get feedback from the entire community," said Melissa Rome, Emergency Planning and Response Coordinator/Community Liaison. "The survey, which only takes about five minutes to complete, lets us know

Once the top three areas of concern are identified, local agencies will strategize about how to help improve conditions in those areas over the next five years. "In this time of limited resources, it is becoming increasingly important that we prioritize our efforts," said Public Health Administrator Douglas Toole. "The surveys help us to identify which conditions are most important to Vermilion County residents."
