## Organizers seek volunteers for light display, hope deer population grows by leaps and bounds

Organizers of Hoopeston's Light Up McFerren Park project hope the number of deer displays will grow by leaps and bounds, in memory of a city leader.

Randy Carter, was a supporter of the Christmas lights project, particularly liked the deer displays, whether the ones who appeared to be jumping over the park road, those lapping at a small "stream" by the annex or the baby deer on the Pony League field. He hoped one day Hoopeston would have a herd of lighted deer as part of

the display.

In his memory, the lights committee hopes to start "Randy's Herd," a huge herd of deer to light up McFerren Park. Donations towards the herd are being accepted. Those who would like to donate towards the project are asked to call Russ Leigh at (217) 283-9336 to discuss their donation.

Organizers are also looking for volunteers of manpower the next two weekends to get existing light dis-

plays ready for the season.

Ten to 15 able-bodied people who can spend two to four hours testing bulbs and connections are needed for Saturday, Oct. 15. Volunteers are expected to meet at 8 a.m. at the Essex Building.

On Friday, Oct. 21, volunteers are needed to move displays from the Essex Building to McFerren Park, where setup will begin at 8 a.m. Saturday, Oct. 22. Putting displays in their locations and anchoring them is expected to be an all-day event but anyone who can donate even a few hours is asked to come. Lunch will be served.
