R-A, B-H boards to hold public meetings on co-op school

Rossville-Alvin and Bismarck-Henning school boards will hold public meeting to discuss the possibility of the districts joining to form a cooperative high school

A meeting will begin at 6 p.m. Wednesday at Rossville-Alvin Grade School. A similar meeting for Bismarck-Henning residents will be held at 6 p.m. Tuesday, Oct. 25 in the Wilcox Gym.

At each meeting, members of both boards will present information on forming a cooperative high school and answer questions related to that issue.

Under a cooperative high school, each district would pay its tuition rate towards the school, which would be

overseen by a governing board made up of members of each school board.

A cooperative agreement agreed to by the districts would address areas such as staff, programs, financing and transportation, among others.

Rossville-Alvin officials broached the subject of a cooperative high school with Bismarck-Henning in 2003. Hoopeston Area officials agreed to meet Bismarck-Henning's offer but the issue became stalled when residents presented a petition to the Hoopeston Area board - signed by 1,072 people - asking that the board keep the Cornjerker name in any cooperative venture.

In 2004, voters approved deactivating Rossville-Alvin
