**Cissna Park man dies in wreck**

A 54-year-old Cissna Park man was killed when his tractor collided with a large truck in rural Cissna Park.

Mark S. Schmid was driving the tractor when at 300 North and 1300 East roads in Pigeon Grove Township.

Mr. Schmid was pronounced dead at 4:05 p.m. Wednesday at Carle Hoopeston Regional Hospital, said Vermilion County Coroner Peggy Johnson.

According to police reports, a second person was airlifted to Carle Foundation Hospital in Urbana.

Police said both vehicles had farm equipment attached when they collided.

The accident is under investigation by Iroquois County Sheriff's Department. Cissna Park ambulance and fire departments also responded to the call.

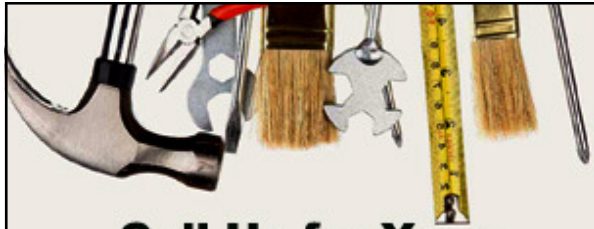

Elysha Wells, 19, of Hoopeston, was ticketed for making an improper turn after an accident at 6:04 p.m. Wednesday.

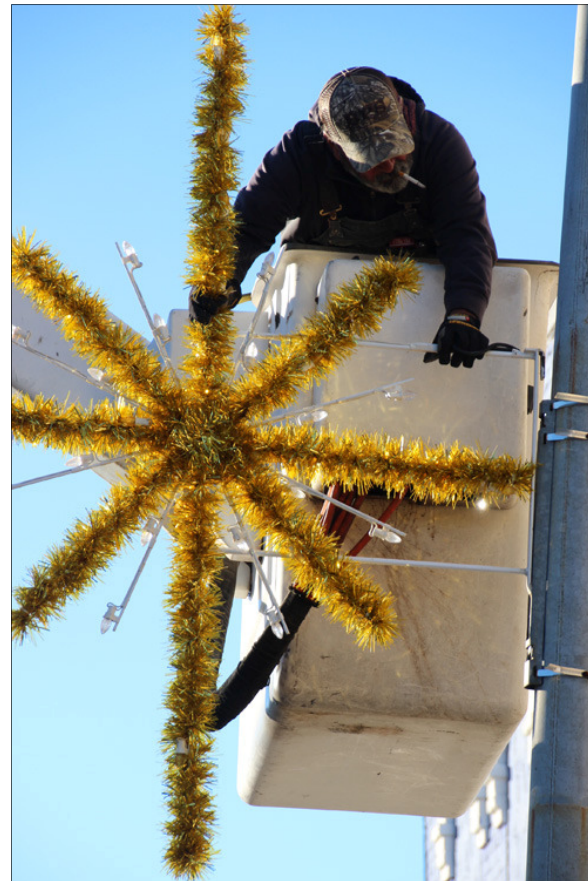
