Council full again after Anderson sworn in to Ward II seat

Hoopeston City Council has its full complement of members after Ryan Anderson was sworn in Tuesday night to represent Ward II.

Anderson, owner of Anderson Funeral Home, fills the unexpired term of Randy Carter, who died in September.

In other business, the council unanimously approved a resolution giving Mayor Bill Crusinberry the authority to purchase the Essex Building from the county tax trustees.

Ald. Bill Goodwine, acting as mayor pro tempore, said the cost is \$639, which includes the minimum bid of \$600 that would have been required at a tax sale, along with filing fees.

Officials have hoped to have someone to redevelop the property, located on Rt. 1, removing the eyesore and turning it into an attractive addition to the city.

City attorney Andrew Mudd said getting a copy of the deed and contract back could take 90-120 days.


