A months' long effort to find a new superintendent for the Hoopeston Area school district did not result in a successful candidate, so the board of education will open

a new search in the new year. The Illinois Association of School Boards, hired to conduct the initial search, has reopened it, said Russ Walder, HA board president, at Thursday's monthly meeting. Applications for the position will close at noon January 20, 2017.

In May, the board approved paying \$7,400 for the IASB's services. That fee covers subsequent searches until a superintendent is found.

From the initial search, four candidates were interviewed but there was not a consensus on any of the candidates, he said. Before beginning the search, district officials conducted surveys of administrators, staff and the community to determine which traits a new superintendent should have. Leadership was at the top of all three, leading the board to look for someone who can "come and get involved in the community," Walder said.

With the new search, a new brochure on the district is being made available to prospective superintendents. Much of the information is the same; however the district is now offering a multi-year contract to the successful candidate, which would make the job more attractive, Walder said. In-district residency is also a requirement.

The new superintendent will replace Hank Hornbeck, who will retire in 2017.

In other business, the board:

• approved the purchase of new uniforms for the Hoopeston Area Marching Cornjerkers.

Brought up by band director Patrick Brooks at last month's meeting, the board approved a \$34,032.75 quote from DeMoulin Co., of Greenville, which will provide 80 band uniforms for band members and five for drum majors, Hornbeck said.

• Heard from Hornbeck that, contrary to a news article that said the state would fully fund schools, Illinois is behind in payments for categoricals (items like transportation costs) and owes Hoopeston Area \$270,000.

• Approved rehiring attorney Bill Nelson for calendar year 2017, with a \$2,000 retainer.

• Approved the 2016 tax levy and audit.

• Heard reports from board members, Hornbeck and business manager Mark Eighner, who all attended the state school board convention last month.
