Hoopeston Pizza Hut will close its doors for good on December 31 after being in Hoopeston for 40 years. Owner Michael Stegman said less business and mandated upgrades from Yum! Brands Inc. are causing the closure.

## As year ends, so does run of Hoopeston Pizza Hut, 3 others

The end of the year will bring an end to one of Hoopeston's oldest restaurants.

Hoopeston Pizza Hut will close December 31, said franchisee Michael Stegman.

Stegman of Wichita, Kan., owns Illinois Pizza Company, will also close Pizza Huts in Watseka, Monticello and Paxton, and last month closed the Pizza Hut in Gibson City.

Stegman cited economic factors as reasons for closing the chain he's had for 30 years. "Business is way down," he said. "The company wants me to do a major remodel and it won't cash flow. It's a really sad deal."

The "major remodel," mandated by Pizza Hut and its parent company, Yum! Brands Inc., includes cosmetic and structural exterior changes and new equipment, which would cost about \$200,000 just for the Gibson City Pizza Hut.

In November, when Stegman announced the Gibson City closing, he was quoted in news articles as saying employees would be relocated to other stores, but with his entire business venture closing, employees will have to look for other work.

Stegman first became a Pizza Hut franchisee in 1986. After looking at ventures in Wisconsin, Oregon, Alabama and Washington, he settled on buying the then 10year-old Hoopeston Pizza Hut and its counterpart in Gibson City. He went on to build new restaurants in Watseka



Although he is getting out of the Pizza Hut business, he hopes his customers will not. "There's a Pizza Hut conveniently located in Danville," he said. "As for Abe. He's the manager. He'll treat you right."
