

Vermilion County Republicans are looking for a qualified candidate to replace retiring county treasurer Sue Stine.

In late January, Stine announced her intent to retire from office on March 31, after having served Vermilion County for 38 years, starting as a clerk for former treasurer Bob Jones.

Stein was elected to her sixth term as treasurer in 2014. The term runs through 2018.
