Civilian Conservation Corps is topic of story/music program

Michigan-based author Bill Jamerson will present a music and storytelling program about the Civilian Conservation Corps at 6:30 p.m. Thursday, March 16, at Hoopeston Public Library. The program will include stories, a video clip from Jamerson's PBS film, excerpts from his novel and singing original songs with his guitar.

The Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) was a federal works program created by President Franklin Roosevelt in the heart of the Great Depression. During its nine-year

run from 1933-1942, more than three million young men between the ages of 17 and 25 enlisted across the country. They lived in work camps run by the Army and were paid one dollar per day. \$25 per month was sent home directly to their families.

A camp in Vermilion County, near Oakwood, built Kickapoo State Park. Across Illinois, the CCC planted trees, worked on soil erosion control, cleared ditches, constructed roads and bridges and helped bring
