Former John Greer teacher hired to lead Hoopeston Area

Suzzette Hesser knows a bit about the Hoopeston Area School District, both as a teacher and a parent of students who attended the school.

Now she will get to know the district from a different angle.

Hesser was hired as the district's new superintendent at the school board meeting Tuesday evening.

"I am so excited to be coming back to work with the board, the students, the staff and the families," she said after the unanimous board vote.

"My passion is to inspire others to achieve their dreams through education. It is truly an honor to have the opportunity to work with the students, staff and community to continue the tradition of excellent in the Hoopeston Area schools and Expect More!"

Hesser, a Bismarck native, began her teaching career at John Greer approximately 22 years ago, teaching fifth grade. After about seven years in Hoopeston, she was hired by the Sterling Public School District. There, she

served as teacher, and principal in a pre-K-8 district.

In what some might consider a step back, in 2014, Hesser went back to teaching. She is currently a fifth grade teacher at Lincoln Elementary. "I didn't want to spend too much time away from teaching," she said. "I think that happens sometimes and you lose sight of the students."

Hesser, 47, graduated from Eastern Illinois University, Charleston, with a bachelor's degree in elementary education. She completed a master's degree in educational administration at EIU and is currently working on her doctorate in educational leadership from Aurora University in Aurora. Her dissertation is on improving in-service teacher development.

At John Greer, Hesser had the distinction of becoming the first teacher in Vermilion County to earn National Board Teacher Certification. She attended Harvard University's Graduate School of Education Principal Center in Boston, Mass., for intensive instruction on the use of data and change leadership. She was also chosen to participate in the AASA (School Superintendents Associa-

"I am beyond thrilled to be here," Hesser said after the meeting. "My husband and I loved being here."

When she began teaching at John Greer, Hesser's children were in kindergarten through John Greer. When they left, the youngsters were in Honeywell through middle school and the family was involved in many areas of the community, including youth sports and church. "We had a great experience," she said.

When Hesser takes the reins on July 1, she plans to spend several months "listening and learning" to staff, students, parents and the community."

Hesser was hired with a three-year contract at a base salary of \$120,000, said board President Russ Walder, who called the search for a new superintendent "a rewarding experience," saying the board "interviewed people from all over the state."

Walder gave a brief history of the search, which started in May when the board hired the Illinois Association of School Boards, at \$7,400, to conduct a nationwide search to replace Supt. Hank Hornbeck, who has served in that capacity since July 2007.

That search resulted in four candidates interviewed but none hired after the board did not reach a concensus, Walder said. A second search began in January.

"This was the only position I applied for," Hesser said of the search.

Hesser and her husband, Scott, have three adult children, Alex, Andrew and Jennifer Brady. They also mentor two young men, Andrew and Joseph, who live with their family.
