# Woman jurist, justice honored with building name change

A Vermilion County woman whose name is synonymous with the field of law will have her name emblazoned on the county's law building.

After recent action taken by the Vermilion County Board, the county courthouse will be known as the Rita B. Garman Vermilion County Courthouse, in honor of the Illinois Supreme Court justice.

The vote to rename the building was unanimous.

Garman was born in Aurora and was valedictorian of the Class of 1961 at Oswego High School. After earning a B.S. in economics from the University of Illinois in 1965, she went on to receive her law degree from the University of Iowa College of Law, despite the fact that she was told by a professor to pursue another career, that she would fail as an attorney and that she was taking up a seat that would have been better filled by man.

From 1969-73, Garman worked as a county assistant state's attorney. In 1986, she became a circuit judge of



the Fifth Judicial Circuit. She was appointed to the Illinois Supreme Court in 2001 and elected to the court in 2002, representing the Fourth District. In 2013, she was elected to a three-year term as state Supreme Court Justice, only the second woman to hold that position.

Her term on the court will end in 2022.
