### Maul, Pugh square off to be Grant Road Commissioner

Just the Facts is spotlighting candidates running in contested elections for Hoopeston Area School Board, which has contests for both in and out of the original Hoopeston School District; Hoopeston City Council, which has a contest in Ward 2; and Grant Township.

Grant Township voters have a choice of who will be the township's road commissioner for the next four years.

Incumbent Republican Marty Maul is being challenged by Independent candidate Jered Pugh in the April 4 election.

Maul has been the commissioner for the last four

years but has 28 years total on the township road crew. He performs both the administrative duties of commissioner and continues to do road maintenance.

The major challenge for the road commissioner is trying to keep roads in decent shape with the funds available, Maul said.

Maul, 63, and his wife, Patty, have two daughters and three granddaughters.

Pugh, 31, said a major issue is making sure roads are paved, not just graveled. Another is being fiscally responsible while maintaining a high level of equip-
